

If you have ever watched an episode of "The Dukes of Hazzard," you've seen Tom Wopat play the part of Luke Duke, King of the Hood Slide. He's also the star of stage, screen and other TV programs. Along with Dukes, Wopat has appeared on Home Imporovement, Cybill and Murder She Wrote, most recently in a popular film called Diango Unchanged and has even been nominated for Tony Awards for work on Broadway in Annie Get your Gun and A Catered Affair. Visit Wopat throughout the weekend in Building T and snag an autograph, snap a photo or just talk to him about his time on the show as one of Georgia's most popular outlaws. ■ The Ramchargers

In 1959 a group of engineers from Chrysler Corporation began to participate in the nation's new craze, "drag racing." They started with a 1949 Plymouth business coupe named "The High and Mighty." By the 1960 race season, this group created the team named Ramchargers. The Ramchargers were named after the "long-horn" intake manifold that powered the early Chrysler 300 series. In 1963 the Ramchargers became nationally famous with two factory-sponsored team cars, each using an automatic transmission. Nicknamed "Candymatic." the cars were white with seven candy-apple

red stripes on the top and trunk deck, along with the name Ramchargers, leaning boldly toward the front of the car on each side.

2015 sees the return of Mopar Hall of Famers, the Ramchargers. The Ramchargers will make appearances in the Dodge booth on the Midway. Enthusiasts can sit in on a panel discussion with original members of the Ramchargers in the Seminar Tent. Ramchargers members scheduled to attend include Al Adam, Mike Buckel, Tom Coddington, Barns Danials, Dave Rockwell and John Wehrly. See schedule for times and locations.

■ The Golden Commandos

The Golden Commandos were a group of Chrysler Corporation employees composed of engineers, technicians and mechanics based out of Highland Park, Michigan. In late 1962 they began racing in Super Stock under the Plymouth banner. By '64 they were running the new lightweight Race Hemis and became the first to break into the 11s. For 1965 they built an altered wheelbase Plymouth which won the unlimited class at Super Stock Magazine's meet in nearby York, PA at U.S. 30.

Another car the Golden
Commandos built in 1965 was a
Barracuda called the "Goldfish."
It was powered by a 273 and was
a successful car in its own right
breaking the AHRA F Stock record
its first time out. In 1967 they
campaigned their first true, flip top
Funny Car called the "Dune Buggy."
The Golden Commandos embodied
the slogan "Win on Sunday, sell on
Monday."

We are honored the Golden Commandos join us again this year. The "Goldfish" will accompany the Golden Commandos this weekend at Carlisle.



Mopar Collector's Guide Hall of Fame

















2015 Mopar Hall of Fame

Now in its fourth year, the Mopar Hall of Fame has become one of the "can't miss" events of the Chrysler Nationals. The Mopar world was in desperate need of a way to honor those who made our hobby and industry what it is today and the Mopar Hall of Fame was the answer. Although it was created by Robert Wolf of Mopar Collector's Guide magazine, he is the first to admit that it really belongs to the entire hobby and the other Mopar magazines are more than welcome to participate.

Although most of the inductees are also guests of the show for the weekend, the Hall of Fame offers attendees the opportunity to enjoy dinner, personal stories and more in a very intimate setting. All Hall of Fame inductees and members spend the evening mingling and sharing stories before and after the formal presentations. During the presentations you have the once-ina-lifetime occasion to hear some of the greatest stories right from the source!

Don't let another year go by without attending the Hall of Fame held at the Radisson in nearby Camp Hill, PA on Saturday evening. Festivities begin at 6:30 with a mixer followed by dinner at 7:30 and the Induction Ceremony at 8:30. Seating

is limited to only 300 and tickets can be purchased at the various Mopar Collector's Guide displays at the show (see page 51).

Carl Kiekhaefer

Carl Kiekhaefer never intended to be an icon of motorsports, but he is now known as the man who set NASCAR on its ear and made Chrysler 300s famous. The engineering genius decided to enter auto racing in 1954 and started with three Chrysler New Yorker coupes and then bought Chrysler 300s. The amazing 300s started 45 events, and won 22 of them.In two years, he rewrote how stock car racing would be conducted and was the first person to bring major corporate sponsorship to the sport. Carl's operation is recognized as the first "super team" in the history of NASCAR.

Dave Koffel

Dave Koffel's one of the nicest and smartest guys in Mopar drag racing. Koffel began racing in the early fifties, but his "Flintstone Flyer" '48 Packard Gasser of the early sixties launched him on the path that changed the sport forever.By 1965, he had been introduced to Chrysler's Bob Cahill and began running Super Stock Plymouths.In '67, he built and campaigned his iconic Barracuda A/ XS funny car, and by 1968 Chrysler hired Dave to work full time in Cahill's racing group.Dave was one of the major pioneers of Chrysler's initial Pro Stock efforts.He remained with Chrysler until 1980 when he left to open his own racing shop. Dave developed the famous B-1 heads and has built numerous drag cars.

■ Virgil Exner

Virgil Exner will forever be tied to his styling work for Chrysler known as "The Forward Look." Exner began his styling career in 1938, working for the legendary Raymond Loewy then was hired directly by Studebaker. In 1949, Exner joined Chrysler and worked on the design of virtually every Chrysler made from 1950 through 1962. His work with fins, interiors, and exotic grilles put Chrysler on the cutting edge of fashion. Exner left Chrysler in 1961, going on to design boats with his son and he continued to design exotic cars the rest of his life. Exner passed away in 1973 from his longfought battle with a heart condition.

■ "Big Willie" Robinson

"Big Willie" was a New Orleans native who moved to LA in 1962 and joined the Army. After returning from Vietnam in 1966, Willie was upset by

the race riots in Southern California. so he convinced feuding gangs to settle their differences through drag racing!That was the beginning of his Street Racer's Brotherhood, which eventually became an international organization.Dodge recognized Willie's good efforts in 1969 and presented him with a new Charger Daytona. This led to him becoming close friends with the legendary Keith Black and was now forever associated with winged cars and Hemis. Before passing in 2012, Willie helped inner city kids build and race hot rods.

■ Vanishing Point Challenger

The "Vanishing Point" 1970 Challenger R/T inspired countless children to become Mopar fanatics when the movie gained a cult following in the late seventies. Richard Zanuck of 20th Century Fox was the man insistent on using white '70 Challengers for the film, and five new 1970 R/Ts were delivered by Chrysler; four were 440 fourspeed cars and the fifth was a 383 automatic. The movie was remade in 1997 for Fox Television, again featuring white 1970 Challenger R/ Ts, this time with a highly altered story. That movie, like the first, soon gained cult-like status among the automotive faithful. These white Challengers have earned their place in the history books.

Buddy Arrington

Buddy Arrington is a legendary figure in NASCAR and Mopar history. Arrington began professional NASCAR racing in 1964 behind the wheel of his Dodge hardtop. What makes Arrington unique in the history of the sport was his dedication and loyalty to Chrysler. In 1985, his Imperial became the last Chrysler product in NASCAR until Dodge reentered the sport in 1999. As prolific a racer as Buddy was, he never won a single race. In his 560 career starts, his highest finish was seventh.Buddy never abandoned the Mopar banner until Mopar completely abandoned him, pulling all sponsorships in 1985. For loyally racing Chrysler products probably longer than anyone else, Buddy

Arrington more than deserves his place in Mopar history.

Dick Maxwell

Dick Maxwell could easily be considered the most important executive in the history of Chrysler's performance cars. Maxwell began working for Chrysler in 1959 as a student engineer and by the late sixties was in charge of Chrysler's performance division and would later become Chrysler's vehicle performance racing manager. He also helped design and bring the Max Wedge cars into production, along with the early Hemi cars. Maxwell pioneered the link between Chrysler and the aftermarket parts industry, and was instrumental in getting the 440 Six Pack cars introduced. Regrettably, Dick Maxwell passed away due to injuries suffered in a motorcycle accident in 2002.



■ Teddy Spehar

Ted "Teddy" Spehar's shop wasn't far from Chrysler's engineering facilities in Detroit, so it was natural he had a relationship with Chrysler's racing operations. Spehar gained notoriety on the national stage in the early sixties when he built a '64 Hemi Dodge Super Stocker for famed racer Wally Booth, and it put him in close ties with Chrysler's drag racing R&D group. Spehar served as Chrysler's "field test" racer, which reached its apex in the opening days of Pro Stock. Teddy built the famed 1970/1971 Challenger Motown Missile, driven by Don Carlton, and also built the Motown Missile 'Cuda and Duster, becoming one of the foremost innovators in the early days of Pro Stock drag racing.

Charlie Stang

Charles "Charlie" Stang was Carl Kiekhaefer's right-hand-man

throughout the glory days of their foray into NASCAR. Stang was the man responsible for coming up with countless innovations we now take for granted, such as the paper air filter.It was Charles' engineering that made the Kiekhaefer Chrysler 300s the first stock cars to break 140 mph, and which caused every other team in NASCAR countless hours of frustration. His remarkable engineering achievements place Stang in a very small group, as he actually received the American Success Award from President H.W. Bush at the White House in 1989 - an accolade very few people in motorsports have ever achieved.

Lee Smith

Lee Smith is perhaps one of the most colorful drag racers from the Midwest, thanks in large part to his incredibly colorful "Crazee 'Cuda" Hemi Pro Stocker and the '67 Plymouth "Whackee Wagon." The rainbow-colored racers were recognizable a mile away, but Lee's affiliation with Plymouth goes well back before those cars, to his racing Super Stock Plymouths in the early sixties, and then becoming one of the six drivers to receive a factory altered wheelbase A/FX Plymouth in 1965.Smith's "Haulin' Hemi II" A/FX altered car is perhaps his best-known ride, and certainly the car which put Lee Smith on the national stage.

Ron Mancini

Ron Mancini may always be affiliated with the yellow '68 Hemi Super Stock Darts he drove from 1970 through 1976. Ron's Mancini Racing Team cars were instantly recognizable, but his career in racing is more diverse than people realize. Ron spent 37 years working for Chrysler, first as an engineer, then in production management. He also taught engineering and drive line mechanics at the Mo-Tech Institute. Starting his racing days in 1967 with a '63 Plymouth, he graduated to a '64 Hemi Dodge, then landed a Hemi Dart. Coming out of retirement in the nineties to race Nostalgia Max Wedge, he returned yet again in 2006 when he helped build and test the early Drag Pak Challengers.

or about seven years,
Building G has taken on a
multi-day transformation as
sign painter Kyle Lankford has
painted its solid glass walls
for the Chrysler Nationals. His
famous pop art has made him
a Carlisle celebrity as locals
look forward to watching him
create symbols of classic cars.
The building looks as though
it's jumped into a 60's time warp
before the car show gets started.

Kyle Lankford, of nearby Hanover, was first hired by Ed Buczeskie, event manager, in 2007. Ed wanted Building G to look like a retro dealership and that's exactly what locals thought at first. Many people were concerned that an actual car dealership was moving in and that convinced both Ed and Kyle that their vision was achieved.

As the Chrysler Nationals

approaches each year, Ed and Kyle sit down and brainstorm about the next theme. Brainstorming includes looking over images from past shows and seeing which year model is featured for the upcoming show. Then the main inspiration for the artwork comes from the logos and engines of those featured cars.

As a child growing up, Kyle's father was an art director for the Baltimore Sun and he fell in love with pop art such as Tony the Tiger and Count Chocula. Eventually an old sign painter was nice enough to show Kyle the ropes and soon he was hooked. After 13 years mainly doing car-related gigs as well as cartoons for books and newspapers, his most famous pieces come from Building G. Many car enthusiasts from all over the world take pictures of their cars

 $in \ front \ of \ his \ paintings.$

"People will line up to have their photo taken in front of a specific window. Some have even put my pictures in magazines and books that I've never seen, and that's really flattering" shared Lankford.

Kyle says he seems to spend more time thinking of how he's going to do his art, rather than actually spending time doing it. There is a lot of thought that goes into each and every one of his pieces making them unique in their own special way.

As he paints the windows in front of Building G, he balances on his ladder listening to music, painting his artwork mainly free-handed while also using stencils and outlines. His passion for his craft shines as he brings his art work together.
